
### Application notice

### Vali Gas Field

It is advised that Vintage Energy Ltd has lodged a site-specific environmental authority application in accordance with the requirements of the *Environmental Protection Act 1994*.

This site-specific application relates to the Vali Gas Field (PL1125), which is located in ATP 2021 within the Cooper Basin, in the Shire of Bulloo in Queensland (see Figure 1). The closest township is Innamincka, South Australia, situated approximately 40 km to the north west of the Vali Gas Field.

The Vali Gas Field includes five wells (three existing and two proposed), associated flowlines and an already permitted export pipeline across a combined 41.99 ha of disturbance. The site-specific application consists of one document and it may be inspected or accessed at the following address:
